Biography

Born in London but raised in the Cotswold Hills, Sue can't remember a time when she didn't sing; falling in love with words and poetry, roots and folk music when she studied English at Manchester. Later, living in West Wales and then Bath, Sue found folk clubs and sessions, learning traditional songs, guitar playing and developing her craft. Then she began to write.

"Flight" released in 2016 was Sue's first album of original songs. It was well received with stripped back arrangements and intimate vocals, influenced by a love of American folk music & the poets of the 1960s. Neville Farmer, Music Journalist said, "Wonderful! We felt as if we were hearing the spirit of Laura Nyro, Joan Baez, Leonard Cohen, Joni Mitchell, Bob Dylan, Woodie Guthrie and more all rolled into one."

"Darkling", Sue's second album, returns to gentle romanticism with a contemporary folk feel. It celebrates a renewed connection to the English landscape and the late Victorian poetry, which inspires so much of it. Sue Harding is a dynamic solo performer. She writes some joyous upbeat tunes flavoured with Americana themes and folk tales. Her songs combine grit and delicacy to tell stories from an imagined Wild West peopled with bandits and heartbreakers all delivered with 'exemplary guitar playing and exquisite vocals' RnR

There is a retro sensibility to much of Sue's original music but expect a few well chosen covers as well. Sue Harding can fill a stage with just a nylon stringed guitar and that voice, but sometimes brings along a harmony singer and a few friends to create that bigger sound.
